Please join us for the Eucharistic Procession following mass on the Feast of Corpus Christi, Sunday, June 18th.

When the Eucharist is carried through the streets in a solemn procession with singing, the Christian people give public witness of faith and devotion toward the sacrament. The annual procession on the feast of Corpus Christi has a special importance and meaning for the pastoral life of the parish or city. It is therefore desirable to continue this procession when circumstances permit and when it can truly be a sign of common faith and adoration.

Pope Paul VI writes of special forms of worship of the Eucharist, *"The Catholic Church has always displayed and still displays this latria that ought to be paid to the Sacrament of the Eucharist, both during Mass and outside of it, by taking the greatest possible care of consecrated hosts, by exposing them to the solemn veneration of the faithful, and by carrying them about in procession to the joy of great numbers of the people."*

May our processions also bring joy to all who participate! This is not an unfounded joy, but one founded on the knowledge that Christ comes to us, to be among us, to make his dwelling in our midst, to teach us, and lead us to the father.
